Building History

The Pacific & Idaho Northern Railway (P&IN) reached north from Weiser, Idaho to the picturesque Meadows Valley. It opened the depot doors in 1911. The graceful brick Italianate style depot also housed corporate railroad offices. The Couer 'd Or Development Company, headed by the P&IN Railway president, created the Village of New Meadows that year.

By the late 1970's the Depot was destined for destruction. Will Kerby, former head of J.I. Morgan Logging, was responsible for saving the Depot from its demise. He is also responsible for donating the land on which the Depot is located. In 1978 the building was placed on the National Register of Historic Places.

In 2025 the ACHS and the City of New Meadows agreed to transfer ownership of the depot to the city and become City Hall. The building once again became an integral part of the city. The ACHS shares space in the building, continues to have exhibits, meetings, educational presentations and has restoration oversight of the building to maintain its historic status.



The ACHS cannot revive faded memories of the Valley but we can preserve the Valley's history and assist in providing a facility and programs to present history, education for present and future generations.

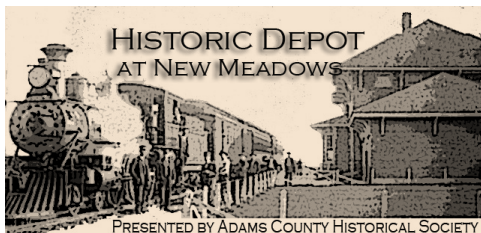
